The Iron Shop Sponsors Vintage Car Race for Charity

The Iron Shop is a proud sponsor of this year's Pittsburgh Vintage Grand Prix (PVGP). The race, which is celebrating its 20th year, will be held at Schenley Park in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania on Saturday, July 20 and Sunday, July 21.

Sanctioned by the Vintage Sports Car Club of America, the PVGP is one of the most widely attended vintage race events in the United States, drawing more than 300,000 spectators. The event is unique because it is the only vintage race in the nation that is held exclusively on city streets over a 2.33 mile twisting course. The course has five 180-degree corners (hairpin turns), nine additional turns, and a quarter mile straight-line finish.

Presented by the volunteer run Pittsburgh Grand Prix Association, the PVGP is both an entertainment and charity event. Funds for the event are raised through corporate sponsorships, program advertising, patron parking and the sale of memorabilia. Admission to the event is free. All monies raised during the race go towards the Allegheny Valley School and the Autism Society of Pittsburgh.

The Allegheny School is an organization serving children and adults with mental retardation and physical handicaps. The mission of Allegheny Valley School is to provide quality programs and facilities to help individuals with mental retardation to function to their full potential and live with purpose and dignity.

The Autism Society of Pittsburgh provides infor-

mation, referral and advocacy services for autistic individuals, their parents, families and professionals who work with them.

Over the years, more than \$1.6 million has been raised for the two organizations.

"How long will it take my spiral stair kit to be delivered to me, and can I pick-up my stair kit from one of the branches?"

Most Metal Spiral Stair Kits can be picked up at any of our showroom locations (California, Florida, Texas, Illinois, Connecticut and Pennsylvania). Be sure to call first for availability.

If you decide to have your spiral stair kit shipped directly to your door, delivery times may vary depending on the type of stair you order – basic metal kit delivery takes two weeks from payment; basic oak kit delivery takes four to six weeks from payment; delivery of an oak stair kit with solid oak handrail takes eight to ten weeks from payment; and delivery of Victorian One kits take twelve weeks from payment.
